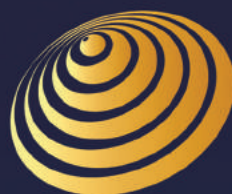

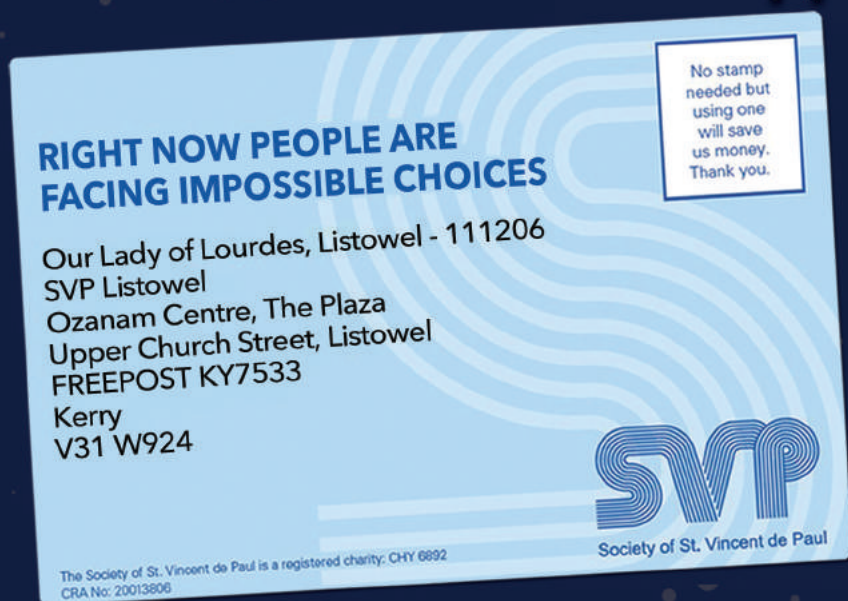

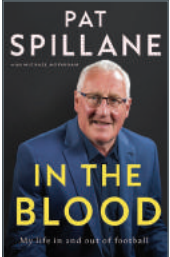

BT SUCCESS FOR PRESENTATION LISTOWEL

Congratulations to Siún O'Brien Ellen Murphy (1st Year) Abbie Mazzelle (TY) and Emma Heaphy (5th year) from Presentation Secondary School who have qualified for this year's BT Young Scientist Exhibition in January.

Siún and Ellen, 1st Year are investigating the effect the menstrual cycle has on 13-14-year-old girls concentration levels at school. Siún and Ellen have qualified under a new section this year developed by BTYSE Health and Wellbeing. Emma and Abbie are conducting a statistical investigation to determine if people would be willing to move to a remote island given the necessary resources.

It as a huge accomplishment to be one of the 550 selected projects, as there were over 2000 applications for BT this year. Their success is a testament to their hard work and dedication as a young scientists. The whole school community in Pres Listowel look forward to supporting you on your journey.

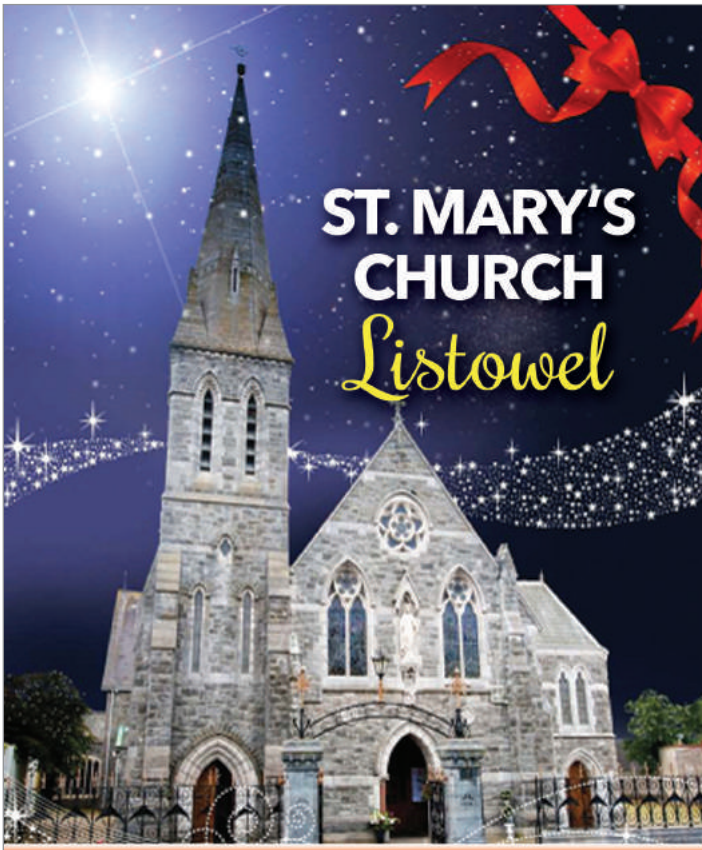
