AN SEANCHÁÍ – KERRY WRITERS' MUSEUM PRESENTS RUSHES | LUACHAIR

An Seanchai – Kerry Writers' Museum, in partnership with Maynooth University and the Heritage Council, presents **Rushes | Luachair**, a specially commissioned exhibition and programme of workshops celebrating women's moving image art practice, timed to coincide with Imbolc | Féile Bríde 2026.

Taking place on Fri 30 and Sat 31 January 2026, **Rushes | Luachair** brings together the work of five artists - Lisa Fingleton, Laura Fitzgerald (curator), Bláithín Mac Donnell, Lorraine Neeson, and Mieke Vanmechelen - whose practices explore themes of land, identity, peripherality and productive liminality through film, analogue and digital media.

The exhibition uses the metaphor of rushes / luachair - both as marshland associated with marginal spaces and as a term for raw film footage - to examine hidden, overlooked and in-process work. - Laura Fitzgerald's new moving-image works, including The other's Other, interwoven with collages and a new publication.
- Bláithín Mac Donnell's collages, photographic slideshow, camera obscura, and live performance The Road Cuts Through.
- Lorraine Neeson's nocturnal moving-image work Frequencies (After Light / Near Dark) alongside a neon installation, There.
- Mieke Vanmechelen's film Bits of Me, charting family exchanges within the Caha Mountains over five years.





Philip O'Connell, Chapel Street, Tarbert and former parish priest of Ballylongford. Fr. Philip was buried in St. Mary's Graveyard, Tarbert.
