FINE GAEL SENATOR MIKE KENNELLY WELCOMES AGREEMENT ON SHORT-TERM LETTING FRAMEWORK

On Tuesday last Fine Gael Senator Mike Kennelly welcomed confirmation from the Minister for Enterprise, Tourism and Employment, Peter Burke TD, that agreement has been reached with the Department of Housing, the Taoiseach and the Tánaiste in relation to short-term letting.

Senator Kennelly said:

"I understand from the Minister for Enterprise, Tourism and Employment, Peter Burke TD, that agreement has now been reached with the Department of Housing, the Taoiseach and the Tánaiste around short-term letting.



This is a matter I have raised directly with both the Minister and the Tánaiste, and I was glad to receive this update late last night.

The Minister has recognised that the sector urgently needs clarity so that operators can plan for the upcoming tourism season. I understand that an agreement in principle has now been reached to allow short-term letting operators based in towns with a population of 20,000 or less to continue to provide this critical service.

In reaching this agreement, the Minister is striking a careful balance between the need to address housing supply and the importance of protecting rural and regional tourism, along with the many jobs that depend on it. It is also widely accepted that cities provide the greatest opportunity for short-term letting properties to be returned to the long-term rental market.

Further clarity is expected later this week, and I understand that the Department of Housing will be issuing new guidance to Local Authorities in relation to planning permission.

The introduction of the new short-term letting register has been welcomed by the sector and is expected to come into force this summer, once the necessary legislation is passed.

While planning permission will still be required, I am hopeful that a workable solution can be found to allow operators who have been in operation for seven years or more to be exempt from planning requirements."

Our narrator understands good love stories - their secrets, their highs and free falls. But her greatest love story, the one she lived, never followed the rules.

She was in her senior year of college when star students Sam and Yash swept her into an intoxicating world of academic fervour, rapid-fire banter and raucous card games. Their lives became quickly intertwined - with friendship but also with unpredictable passions and the intimations of first love.

Decades later, she is a successful writer, living a comfortable life with her husband and children, when a surprise visit brings the past crashing into the present, forcing her to confront the decisions and deceptions of her youth.

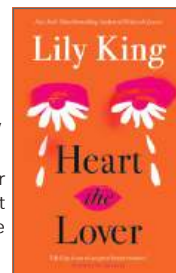
